EASELS

CANVAS

- **IMPORTANT:** Bring two or three of the biggest pieces you have that you would like to MAKEOVER -- the bigger the better. Work should be on stretched canvas.
- **AND a 36 x 48 x 1-1/2" blank canvas.** If you need to purchase your canvas, the Dick Blick Premier Cotton Canvases meet Anne's requirements. Prices range from \$35.31 each to \$26.83 for 6 or more. See link below.

CLEAN UP

- Odorless mineral spirits for oils. Medium of your choice for acrylic.
- Rags, towel, paper towel

PAINTS

- Bring your choice of colors in acrylic or oil
- Calligraphy or drawing permanent inks

BRUSHES and PALETTE KNIVES

- Several 3 and 4 inch brushes, plus an assortment of others, 2 inch minimum. Brushes should be hog hair (not synthetic or foam).
- Many cheap and packaged sizes of hog hair house paint brushes are available at Home Depot.
